Mr. Hodge,

The North Dakota Department of Health (NDDH) previously reviewed information regarding the use of *RhoGard Ultra DP* as a heat transfer fluid for closed-loop geothermal heat exchange systems. In our March 23, 2009 letter, we indicated that, "The NDDH does not object to the use of *RhoGard Ultra DP* as a heat transfer fluid provided that the composition of the product does not change, the product is used according to the manufacture's specifications, and the product does not adversely affect waters of the state."

It is our understanding that *RhoGard Ultra DP* has been renamed "*EnviroGard*". Consequently, the NDDH does not object to the use of *EnviroGard* as a heat transfer fluid provided that the composition of the product is the same as *RhoGard Ultra DP* and does not change, the product is used according to the manufacture's specifications, and the product does not adversely affect waters of the state
